**Do you get any financial support for your undergraduate education and living expenses from any of the following sources?**

New students were asked whether they get financial support from any of the following sources: parents or other relatives, aid that must be repaid (such as loans), or aid that need not be repaid (such as grants, work-study, scholarships, military funding, DVR, or worker retraining funds). A total of 16.4% indicated that they receive financial aid from parents or other relatives, 50% indicated that they receive aid that must be repaid, and 73.2% report that they receive aid that need not be repaid.
