### Supplemental Report on Utilization of Campus Resources and Participation in Community Activities by On- and Off-campus Housing Status

An analysis was performed to test for differences on responses to the Student Experience Survey between students living on campus and those living off campus. Students were put into groups (living on or off campus) based on their responses to the question, "Where are you currently living?"<sup>1</sup> There were two sets of questions that were analyzed for this report, questions pertaining to the use of campus resources and participation in community activities.

### Utilization of Campus Resources

Students were asked, "How often have you used the following campus resources so far this academic year?" and then given a list of campus resources. Students responded on a scale of Not at All, A Little, Some, or A Lot on each item.

For students *living on campus*, means were highest on the items:

- Student on-campus housing (such as living on campus or using housing resources such as gathering/meeting spaces);
- Library facilities and services;
- Intercity Transit bus service.

For students *living off campus*, means were highest on:

- Library facilities and services;
- Computer Center, Computer Applications Lab, or computer workshops;
- Financial Aid Services (such as receiving financial aid assistance or requesting additional information at the office).

The following charts show campus resources broken out by students living on-campus and students living off of campus.

Students living off campus indicated more use of:

- Computer center, computer applications lab, or computer workshops
- Financial Aid Services
- Graduate school fair
- Internship fair
- Library facilities and services
