## **Utilization of Campus Resources**

Students were asked how often they use certain campus resources. The resources below are listed in alphabetical order to facilitate locating particular services. Olympia campus respondents indicated that they used the following resources most frequently during the year: Evergreen's website to get information (85.6% reporting using it "Some" or "A Lot"); the library on campus (73.0% reported using "Some" or "A Lot"); library digital online resources (63.7% reported using "Some" or "A Lot"); and the Computer Center, Computer Applications Lab, or computer workshops (66.4% reported using "Some" or "A Lot.") More than a quarter of Olympia campus respondents (28.4%) indicated that they did not use the Academic Advising Office or advising workshops, and 35.6% indicated that they did not attend Academic Fair or Core Fair.
