Ability to Enroll in First Choice of Academic Offerings

Students were asked to indicate whether they were able to enroll in their first choice of academic offerings. The percentage of Tacoma respondents who indicated that they could not enroll in their first choice of academic offerings ranged from 6.5% in Winter 2006 to 10.3% in Fall 2005.

Tacoma respondents who said that they were not able to enroll in their first choice of academic offering in the Fall (N=3) indicated that they would have preferred:

Program offered every other year.

Something in the Education field.

I was able to get into selected classes my first quarter.

Tacoma respondents who said that they were not able to enroll in their first choice of academic offering in the Winter (N=2) indicated that they would have preferred:

Conflict on the schedule--Statistics that I needed to take was offered the same night as another class I desired to take. Attending Tacoma Campus and don't have a lot of flexibility with this.

Something in the Education field.

Tacoma respondents who said that they were not able to enroll in their first choice of academic offering in the **Spring** (N=3) indicated that they would have preferred:

Not enough options. I ended up taking two classes instead of three because I was not interested at all in the classes available.

The other class offered in Tacoma the same time.

Would have preferred another option.
