Tribal: Reservation-based/Community-Determined Programs

Satisfaction with the Learning Environment

Students were asked to indicate their level of satisfaction on a series of questions about their learning environment at Evergreen, ranging from relationships with faculty to their social experiences at Evergreen. For respondents enrolled in Tribal Programs, the factors with the highest means responses and median responses of 4 (indicating "Very Satisfied") are: relationships with faculty; the overall quality of instruction, seminars (as a way of learning), availability of faculty outside of class, and living situation (on or off campus). Items with the lowest mean responses are: amount of time students are able to devote to their academic work, students' ability to keep up with the reading workload, the availability of technical support for use of computers on and off campus, and opportunities for learning new software and working with technology.
