Average FTE Load: Average combined Undergraduate and Graduate student FTE generated by quarter by planning unit.
Adjusted FTE Load: Student FTE adjusted by faculty FTE, so that Full-time and Part-time can be combined on an equivalent basis. This is the adjusted average student FTE for all PT and FT faculty within each planning unit category.

Average Headcount: This is the average number of students per faculty category. A student who enrolled in two offerings with the same faculty member would be counted twice (e.g. in program and a contract with same faculty member). Averages are presented for FT and PT faculty separately, as well as the average for the whole planning unit.

For most planning units, both headcount and student FTE generation decreased slightly as the year progressed (fall to spring). The exceptions were Tacoma and Part-time Studies whose average student FTE and headcount increased from fall to spring as student enrollment increased in those academic offerings.

Annual Average $=$ Average Student Load per Quarter based on the sum of Fall 00, Winter 01, and Spring 01 FTE divided by three. However, many faculty did not teach all three quarters. Averages for faculty who only taught one or two quarters during this time period were figured based on the quarters in which they were teaching.

## Quarterly Average Student Load by Faculty Type

Instead of using a planning unit categorization, the following table shows average student load for each quarter by type of faculty.

## Category Definitions:

- Full-time Faculty whose primary teaching role is within the undergraduate curriculum.
- Part-time faculty whose primary teaching role is within the undergraduate curriculum: includes half-time contract faculty, Tacoma Director (.5), and full-time faculty who have arranged to teach less than full-time during a particular quarter)
- Faculty primarily in Graduate Studies: includes full-time faculty whose primary teaching role is in the graduate curriculum and MES and MPA directors who have a .5 teaching role. Note: Adjunct faculty hired specifically to support graduate electives are not included in this category. There were 3 such adjuncts in fall, 1 in winter, and 1 in spring.
- Adjuncts: all staff and faculty paid as adjuncts, including the few who teach in graduate studies and at the Tacoma campus.
- Faculty on Rotation: full-time faculty whose primary role for the quarter is on rotation to Library, Advising, or Deanship (also includes spring quarter PUC assignments).
- Non-adjunct Staff: all staff members who generate student credit without additional adjunct faculty income.
