## End-of-program Review Assessment

The End-of-program Review (EPR) was created by Evergreen's Assessment Study Group to improve cross-curricular general education, and to help the college recognize and articulate curricular offerings. In academic year 2001-2002, the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment began surveying faculty at the end of each program. Faculty were asked how they integrated the four main divisions of Liberal Arts, as well as several skill areas, into their programs.
